Getting Ready

Summer Training



Clothing and Equipment Requirements

- Cadets will wear blue t-shirt and black, dark blue or grey shorts during training
- **ONLY** item issued at Training Centre is blue t-shirt
- Cadets **MUST** ensure all other items are purchased or issued to them before they leave
- We will offer supply night before summer training
- Kit list is provided in Joining Instructions

Cadet Offers of Participation

- Cadets must carry accepted “Offers of Participation” signed by their guardian with them
- Escort officer will do their best to also carry extra offers, but not guaranteed. If you do not have a copy please contact the Sqn 715mohawk@gmail.com
- This is your way of giving your permission for your cadet to be there.

Health Cards

- Cadets **MUST** be in possession of a valid Provincial Health Card
- Copies will not be Accepted by the Cadet Training Centres (CTCs)

Medication

- Prescription medication **MUST** be brought in original container and must be enough for the duration of the course
- Non-prescription drugs are **NOT** permitted. If cadets require over the counter drugs medical personal at training centre will administer.
- Cadets with severed anaphylaxis allergies **MUST** bring their epi-pens and must fill out Anaphylaxis Emergency Plan Form

Eyeglasses

- Canadian Armed Forces will not replace lost or broken glasses
- Strongly suggested, if able, that:
 - They have insurance coverage to replace the glasses or,
 - A second pair be sent with the cadet
- Contact lenses not permitted for cadet attending International Exchange or Marksmanship

Immunizations

- Strongly suggested that cadets are up to date on immunizations before arriving
- It is advised that a copy of immunization records are brought with them to CTC
- Immunizations will not be provided
- If an infectious disease breaks out, cadets without immunizations will be excluded from training

Transportation Arrangements

- Cadets travel day before Camp Starts (Sunday)
- Busing is provided; cadets meet at 180 Derry Rd East (Peel Police Station)
 - Some of you already have itineraries
 - Remainder will be posted as soon as they are available
- All luggage must be clearly marked
- Parents may drop off their cadet at CTC instead; no earlier than 1000hrs (10:00am) and no later than 1400hrs (2:00pm)
- All parents **MUST** fill out ***Cadet Transportation Form (Annex E)*** and send with cadet
- If alternate travel arrangements must be made CTC must be notified



Training Centre Routines

Summer Training

Arrival

- Upon arrival cadets will go through in-routine and will be asked:
 - Name
 - Course Attending
 - Health Card
 - Eye glasses
 - Medications and Form (Annex E)
 - Cadet Transportation Form (Annex E)
 - Leave/Pass Authorization Form (Annex F)
 - Code of Conduct (Annex G)

Arrival

- Each cadet will be subject to:
 - A Brief Interview
 - Health screening
 - Kit Inspection

CTC Services and Facilities

- Cadets sleep in multi-occupant, gender specific and access restricted accommodations.
- Generally consists of two-tier bunk beds
- All bedding (sheets, blankets and pillows) are provided.
- Each cadet is provided with a barracks box. **Cadets must provide their own lock.**

CTC Services and Facilities

- Meals are served in cafeteria style mess halls
- It is cadets responsibility to avoid allergens and inform staff of dietary restrictions
- Canteen is available but food is not permitted in living quarters



Medical and Dental Care

- Medical staff, including a conditions, are provided in the case of minor injuries or routine medical conditions
- Dental care is provided for emergency purposes only

Telephones

- Cadets may use payphones available on base
- It is suggested that cadets bring a Calling Cards
- DND phones are only used for emergency situations or as directed by staff
- It is highly suggested that cellphones are not brought to CTC



Postal Services

- Postal services are available daily
- Cadets may write and receive letters while away at CTC
- Cadets should bring supply of postal stamps and envelopes
- CTC Address available in joining instructions

Laundry

- Services vary from centre to centre
- Trenton, Blackdown, HMCS Ontario and Connaught have laundry attendants
- If you are at CTC other than the 4 listed above cadet will need to bring laundry detergent
- Irons and ironing boards are provided
- Cadets must mark **ALL** their clothing with non-soluble ink

Worship

- Each CTC maintains non-denominational staff
- Cadets should advise CTC staff if they services for their faith

Cadet Banking

- On-site banking service are provided (not typical bank); no ATMs are available at CTC
- Cadets should arrive with cash and will have the opportunity to deposit upon arrival
- There are **NO MANDATORY** charges to attend CTC but cadets often like extra spending money for canteen
- Cadet receive a **TRAINING BONUS** of \$60 per week; at the end of week 1, week 3 and week 6 of courses.

Visits, Leave and Passes

- Training is 0600 (6:00am) to 2000 (8:00pm) 6 days a week, therefore leave must be confined to evenings and weekends
- Cadets will not be able to leave CTC with anyone other than the person or person(s) specified on leave pass (Annex F)

Personal Appearance

- Standards of personal appearance remains the same as at Squadron
- **Males**
 - Suggested that cadets get haircut before leaving
 - Barber available onsite at the cadet's cost
 - Bring ample shaving supplies for duration of course
- **Females**
 - Bring ample hair supplies; elastics, hairnets, gel etc...

Code of Conduct

- Cadets will sign code of conduct upon arrival
- Breaking code of conduct can result in Return to Unit (RTU)

Smoking, Drugs and Alcohol

- Smoking, Drugs and Alcohol are prohibited items
- CTC has a zero tolerance policy and any possession or use will result in a Return to Unit (RTU)

Fraternization

- Fraternization is considered inappropriate and is not permitted.
- Living-quarters are gender exclusive and are off limits to members of opposite sex
- Failure to comply with the above regulations may result in an RTU

Return to Unit (RTU)

- Return to Unit may occur as result of:
 - Disciplinary Reasons
 - Medical
 - Parental Request
 - Training Failure

Graduation

- Each course has a full ceremonial parade similar to our own Annual Ceremonial Review. Parents, family and friends are encouraged to attend
- Cadets do not depart immediately following the parade, cadets must first complete pre-departure procedures with staff
- Cadets not picked up by parents will be provided transportation home via bus
